

The Northern Utah Division is hosting the NMRA National Convention & Train Show in 2019!!!




Everyone is invited to come and participate in this fun and learning experience.

The NMRA Board of Directors, at their annual meeting in Cleveland, unanimously selected Salt Lake City as the location for the 2019 NMRA Convention and Train Show. The convention dates are 07-07-19 to 07-13-19 and the train show dates are 07-12-19 to 07-14-19.

Hostler Tour details Saturday, September 13, 2014. Times as noted.

John Grubb: 6966 S. 475 E., So Weber OPEN: 10 AM to 1 PM

DIRECTIONS; Get on the short stretch of I-84 between Riverdale and Weber Canyon and get off exit 85 and head south (If you go north you run into the toll both.) You will be on 475 E. John's house is the last house on the east side of the street at the intersection with South Weber Dr.

Diamond Loosli: 2961 S. 2000 W., Syracuse OPEN: 10 AM to 5 PM

DIRECTIONS; Go out Antelope Dr. to 2000 W. And turn south on 2000 W. Drive south until you come to a round-about. Continue through on 2000 W. Diamond's house is a log house on the left soon after you get past the round-about.

John Griffin: 1942 N. 150 W., Layton OPEN: 10 AM to 4 PM

DIRECTIONS: From the intersection of Hill Field Rd. and Antelope Dr. head east on Antelope Dr. 150 W. will be the third right hand that you can make and John's house is the 5 th house on the left.

Tim Morris: 5864 S. 4500 W., Hooper OPEN: 10 AM to 5 PM

DIRECTIONS: In Roy, UT at the corner of 1900 W. and 5600 S. note your mileage. Head west on 5600 S. out of Roy. After a curve in the road, it changes to 5500 S. After about 5 miles, look for 4300 W. and turn left onto it. Go 1/4 mile and turn right onto 5850 S. t After about 100 yards, turn left onto 4400 W. and after about 50 yards, turn right onto 5900 S. Then turn right on the second street, 4500 W. Tim's house is the 4th house on the east side of the street.
